After fuming the wood, we bleach it giving the patina a long-lasting protection against yellowing. The wood is treated with hardwax-oil and can be soaped and reoiled time after time to nourish and protect the surface patina.






Engineered: 19.5 +/- 0.5 mm, top layer 4.5 +/- 0.5 mm
