



## American Walnut Champagne Hardwax

By brushing the Walnut, we make its surface denser and richer in structure. After the manual application of our custom bleaching lye and two coats of hardwax, the result is a refined and luxurious textured patina. The lively variation in colour mellows out over time, and works very well in planks or herringbone patterns.

<b>Species</b>	American Walnut
<b>Finish*</b>	Hardwax-Oil
<b>Origin</b>	American dark Walnut ( <i>Juglans Nigra</i> ) mainly over 80 years old. Grown in responsibly managed forests in the northern states of the USA.
<b>Maintenance</b>	This finish can be cleaned regularly using our Natural Oil Soap, which feeds and strengthens the surface over time and makes the patina richer and deeper.
<b>Spot repair and Refinish</b>	Professional maintenance with our Maintenance Oil will make this finish richer and protect it over time. Spot repairs are possible with our touch-up kit.



