



## Continental Ash Faded Iceberg Hardwax

Pre-finished by hand, this remarkable selection of Ash has a playful bright Scandinavian touch. The wood is bleached treated with our lye against yellowing. the surface is treated with hardwax-oil and can be soaped and reoiled time after time to feed and protect the surface patina. This finish works best in randomly blended wider and longer boards for floors or walls.


<b>Species</b>	Continental Ash
<b>Finish*</b>	Hardwax-Oil
<b>Origin</b>	European Ash ( <i>Fraxinus Exelcior</i> ) mainly over 80 years old. Grown in responsibly managed central continental European forests.
<b>Maintenance</b>	This finish can be cleaned regularly using our Natural Whitewash Oil Soap, which feeds and strengthens the surface over time and makes the patina richer and deeper.
<b>Spot repair and Refinish</b>	Professional maintenance with our Maintenance Whitewash Oil will make this finish richer and protect it over time. Spot repairs are possible with our touch-up kit.
